Items Accepted for Donation

- Appliances
- Plumbing Fixtures No set-in rust stains, chips or cracks
- Plumbing Supplies
- Cabinets No painted cabinets
- Doors No flat panel doors
- Door and Cabinet Hardware
- Furniture No rips, stains or animal / smoke odor, no floral designs
- Windows Must be usable, Maximum Size 60" High X 42" Wide
- Electrical
- Flooring Unused Ceramic, Vinyl, Hardwood (must be enough to complete a project)
- Pipe: Copper, Black, PVC, Flexible
- Lumber: Molding, Dimensional, Plywood, Trim must be greater than 4 feet in length
- Insulation unused
- Roofing (full bundles)
- Hand and Power Tools, Hardware and Fasteners
- Yard and Garden: Mowers, Blowers, Spreaders, Supplies, Outdoor Furniture

Recycle Items

- Paint <u>Latex Only</u> (\$2.00 / Qt or Gal. \$10/5 Gal container)
- Scrap Metal
- Unable to Accept: Furnaces, Water Heaters, Jetted Tubs, Water Softeners
- Unable to Accept: Window Treatments Blinds, Drapes, Shades, Cornices
- Unable to Accept: Unframed Mirrors / Glass
- Unable to Accept: Florescent Light Bulbs
- Unable to Accept: Mattresses and Box Springs.
- Unable to Accept: Televisions, Entertainment Centers
- Unable to Accept: Small kitchen appliances, Pots & Pans, Utensils, etc.
- Unable to Accept: Medical Equipment
- Unable to Accept: Clothing, Baby Items (cribs, highchairs, strollers, etc.)
